Penn-Mar Human Services is a nonprofit that supports people with intellectual and developmental disabilities to live courageously, whether that's securing a job, being an active member of their community, building independence, or developing new relationships. We do this by supporting people on their own unique personal journeys.



Founded in 1981 by 12 visionary families who teamed up to help their adult children with disabilities unlock new opportunities for independence, our initial budget was just \$2,000 annually.



Today we operate 24 hours a day, 365 days a year, and support 500+ adults with disabilities daily through an array of customizable services and supports. We also support an additional 1,000+ people annually through Low Intensity Support Services. We offer supports throughout Maryland and Pennsylvania, employ roughly 600 team members, and have an annual budget of over \$48 million.
