A different kind of natural support

Alexa, a virtual voice assistant, will be moving into five additional Penn-Mar homes. The expansion of this Smart Home pilot will give us a broader perspective on the ways the people we support increase their independence with smart home technology. Current homes participating in the Smart Home pilot have experimented with the intercom feature to make announcements through the home as well as creating daily or weekly routines for trash, day program pick up, church, and "Alexa, Good Morning!" Team members encourage individuals to interact with Alexa.

Crystal B. has been encouraged and supported over the past year to use her tablet to connect with family and friends. When Crystal's support staff was absent due to illness, she used the tablet independently to call her to tell her she missed her. That same day, Crystal also called her friend Sue! Crystal also uses the tablet to order food at her favorite restaurants. Support staff Dawn created custom pages for each restaurant so she can order meals she enjoys, and the wait staff can easily understand Crystal's order when she uses the tablet. The tablet lets her use her voice instead of staff ordering for her. Recently a comment was made by the family at the annual PCP meeting that Crystal would like to read her Bible and other documents. Dawn began to share information with the team about the Penn-Mar Assistive Tech Loaner Library. Crystal and her family are excited to try new ways to increase independent reading.
